Meeting commenced at 7.30pm

53 Cllr Jones, as Vice-chair, presided and welcomed all Members and the
members of the public to the meeting. She welcomed and introduced the new
Clerk, Siân E Thomas and wished Cllr Richard Salisbury a speedy recovery

54 Apologies:

55 Declarations of Interest:
The Chair asked for any Declaration of Interests. No interests were declared
at this time.

56 Meeting Open to the Public:
Council was adjourned at 7.32pm for the Public Participation Session.

Two points were raised:

a) The condition of the A494.

Action: It was agreed that the Clerk would request a senior highways
engineer from Denbighshire County Council to attend the next
Community Council meeting.

b) Pen y Bryn Common

One person enquired as to the current position and a further raised
concerns about it, including the shooting taking place adjacent to it
and to the progress being made regarding the transfer of the land.

Action: The Clerk to arrange a meeting between members of the
Community Council and a representative from Nantclwyd Hall.

- c) an item regarding community electricity. **Action:** To be reviewed at the next Council meeting.

62 Wind Farm Update

Sarah Merlin gave a very informative update on the Wind Farm. 27 turbines have been installed and 22 are fully operational. It is hoped that monies from the Community Investment fund will be available when all the turbines are operational. A map was circulated detailing the areas eligible for grant funding, however, the boundaries have not yet been fully decided on. Public consultation has taken place regarding the use of the grant and it is proposed to have an open meeting shortly.

Ms Merlin was thanked by the Vice chair.

63 Items brought to the Council's attention by Councillors:

- a) Cllr Edwards mentioned the new sign that had appeared on the Village Green. The sign stated that the area was protected by law and listed a range of activities which were prohibited there. It was agreed that as no particular law was referred to and that there was no name of the instigator of the sign then it was worthless. However, the Council was then informed that the sign has now been removed.
