➤ Pen y Bryn Common (Village Green)

Firstly we would like to record our thanks to all those who, over many years, have put time and effort into enabling the proposed exchange of land between the Llanellidan Community Council and Nantclwyd Estate.

As you may be aware, the proposal to swap the old Village Green (approximately half a mile from the centre of the village) for an area of land at the far end of Hendre Cottages, was the option voted for by the majority in the Village Green - Community Consultation held in 2019.

➤ Looking ahead to 2022 - Llanellidan Community Plan

You may remember, back in the Summer of 2019 the community were invited to complete a questionnaire on a range of community matters, but also asked for views on the future sustainability of the Llanellidan Parish Area.

A group of residents was brought together to work towards implementing some of the ideas put forward in the questionnaire. Although the work was started on developing a Community Plan in the Autumn of 2019, unfortunately the pandemic curtailed any further progress. In 2022 it would be good to get back on track!

Key themes from the Community questionnaire responses included communications (mobile connectivity / reliable broadband / local networking), sustainability of community facilities, transport links, bridleways / public footpaths, and the health / well-being of residents of all ages.
