

King George's Field

King George's field is a public open space for the use and enjoyment of the people, owned by the Fields in Trust. It is situated opposite the Leyland Arms/ Llanelidan Village Hall.

The Community Council has been awarded a Green Communities Grant to fund essential repairs and improvements to the field. The aim is to ensure King George's field is a useable green space, which the community can access and enjoy.

Maintenance to be carried out includes repairs and replacements, where necessary, to gates, gateways, walls and fencing, including improved disability access. New picnic benches and a notice board will be installed. A wild flower buffer zone edging the field will be included as well as the planting of six native fruit trees, to encourage biodiversity. Please see plans below.

The maintenance work will take place between the middle of January and the end of March 2023. There will be opportunity for members of the community to volunteer and help with planting, and hopefully other projects such as bird box building, in the months following the essential repairs.

The Council looks forward to this valuable space being fully accessible and enjoyed by the community.
