- c. Grants – It was agreed that the Council keep a watch on the grants available eg Brenig Wind Ltd and DVSC and apply for those where appropriate.

- a. Cllr.David Edwards told the meeting he was stopped by a young member of the community who raised concerns over the reduction in hours of the Library Service and the impact it would have.
- b. Cllr.Iwan Roberts asked if the Council would consider making a donation to the Wales Air Ambulance. The value to be agreed and a check made as to when the Council last donated.

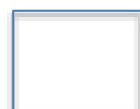
**539. Planning Matters.**
